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1. IMPLEMENT STATE PRINT PROGRAMS IN FCR (OCSE REF #2796)

1.1 Summary of Changes

The Federal Case Registry (FCR) system is being modified to provide states with an option to receive selected FCR and ICR response information in report format. States that opt to receive data in report format can choose one or more of the following responses:

1. Title II Pending Claim
2. SVES Title II
3. SVES Title XVI
4. SVES Prisoner
5. SVES Not Found
6. SSA Death Master Match
7. DMDC Proactive Match
8. Insurance Match
9. ICR

1.2 Background

Some states do not have the ability to program for new initiatives, due to resource or budget constraints. Also, some states do not use COBOL; therefore, they cannot execute the report programs for themselves. This change request will allow those states to still receive the information via reports.

1.3 Description of Changes

The FCR System will send a state's selected response information in 132-byte report format, via a new CyberFusion (CFI) transmission. States that elect to receive response information in a report format will also continue to receive the 920-byte standard response record in the FCR Response Batch Transmission file. All of the FCR print reports for a particular day will be returned to the state in a single FCR Report Transmission file for that day. If a state also elects to receive ICR information in report format, the ICR print report will be transmitted to the state in a separate 132-byte ICR Report Transmission file.

1.4 Impact on States

A state that opts to receive any of the FCR print reports (Title II Pending Claim, SVES Title II, SVES Title XVI, SVES Prisoner, SVES Not Found, SSA Death Master Match, DMDC Proactive Match and/or Insurance Match) must program to receive a new FCR 132-byte Report Transmission file via CFI. If there are multiple FCR print reports (that is, from more

than one of the sources that were selected) created in the same day, the reports will be combined into a single file for transmission.

A state that opts to receive the ICR print report must program to receive a new ICR 132-byte report transmission file via CFI.

States that would like to receive one or more of the available report formats should complete the FCR Print Programs Election Form (See Figure 1-1). When a state is ready to begin receiving report format information, and has set up the necessary CFI process, the completed form must be mailed or faxed to the FCR Options Coordinator:

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1.5 Output Report Specification

States may print the report information on a mainframe line printer or by using a PC. Printing the report from a PC will facilitate splitting the report and distributing it to multiple case workers.

To print using a PC, the following guidelines can be used:

- After the dataset has been created, download the .txt file from the mainframe to a PC.
- Open the file using Microsoft Word, and perform the following:
 - 1) Click **File** on the main menu.
 - Click **Page Layout** on the drop down list.
 - Click **Landscape** on the dialog box.
 - 2) Click **Edit** on the main menu.
 - Click **Select All** on the drop down list.
 - 3) Click **View** on the main menu.
 - Click **Normal** on the drop down list.
 - i. Click the **Font** drop down box.
 - Click **Lucinda Console** on the drop down list.
 - i. Click the **Font Size** drop down box.
 - Click **8**.
- Save the file as a WORD document.
- The Word document is ready to print.
- Print the document and distribute it to workers.
